LIISA PENTTI + CO & NYKY ENSEMBLE



Ref2022, a live adaptation of Brian Eno's music comes to life as a coproduction of the Sibelius Academy's NYKY Ensemble and Liisa Pentti +Co.

The work, created together with six dancers, suggests a new kind of connection between contemporary dance and Eno's music where the meditative music creates singing and historicity of movement.

In every moment the dancers continually modify their movement paths with microscopic precision by observing the dialogue between movement and mind and constantly making choices about space and timing. The rich and unpredictable movement language acts at times as a counterpoint to the soundscape and sometimes independently, without a primary relationship to the music.

The artistic starting points of the piece are Pina Bausch's classic choreographies 1980 - ein Stück von Pina Bausch (1980) and Walzer (1982). From these foundations, Fraudulent Light emerges as a 'ghost theatre': it is loosely based on already existing forms and ideas of performing arts, on what has existed for a long time. Nine performers surrender to the fraudulent light and oblivion in a work that focuses on the ambiguity, ecstasy and love of being human.

RAKKAUS JA JÄRJESTYS PIPSA ENQVIST





19 hours and 34 minutes. That is how long it takes to fall in love. 6792 minutes and 157 listening sessions of Fred Again's song Julia (Deep Diving). That is how long it takes before the memory of falling in love threatens to transform into a simple story. **Pipsa Enqvist**'s 2022 play *Love and Order* (unofficial translation, orig. *Rakkaus ja järjestys*) is a playful and philosophical look into how memories are formed; how love is archived. It would be so lovely if we could store our most precious memories in floating castles, but sadly this is a wish rarely granted to us.

In the play, an unnamed character has fallen in love. In a memory archive, four archivists are tirelessly working on archiving this most cherished memory. Even though they share methods, they still disagree constantly on what is relevant to the process and how best to approach it. However, they agree that there are six categories which they should use when categorising memories: objects, time, sounds, space, speech and... the sixth is never revealed but for them it is clear. The four archivists are not completely alone in their preservation process as they are visited occasionally by the Messenger, who brings them assignments, notes and questions from the outside world and from the person whose memories they are storing.

CYCLE OF DEVELOPMENT EETU VEKKI + C0 (video work)



Cycle of Development is a durational video work in which the absurd scenes blend physical actions and imagination into a dreamlike loop. The piece consists of tableau scenes formed by stationary performers and moving digital images. Household objects and the body are shaped into poetic conflicts and parallels of tenderness and violence. From the folds of repetitive routine emerges a peculiar and intimate world where layers of time and reality intertwine.

The "Cycle of Development" project team includes choreographer and performer Sara Grotenfelt, choreographer and performer Sanni Kriikku, performer Corinne Mustonen, sound and visual artist Eetu Palomäki, and lighting designer and scenographer Saana Volanen. The performers in the work are Sara, Sanni, and Corinne.

Each of the five artists has their own areas of expertise, but they also intersect and overlap. We believe that collaborative work stretching the boundaries of artistic forms allows for unexpected insights, blending of audiences, and a thorough questioning of conventions in different art forms. In addition, the collective provides peer support and the sharing of workload.

In this presentation Corinne Mustonen shares glimpses of text and dance inspired by the collection of poems Tillkortakommanden by Claes Andersson (Söderström 1981).

This dance is fragile yet decisive.

Meanings appear and dissapear in the glimpses, gaps, burps, skips, and turns. At times, it's a silent buzz. It is gathering of soft statements.
